Please be as generous as you can. So many lives depend on it.

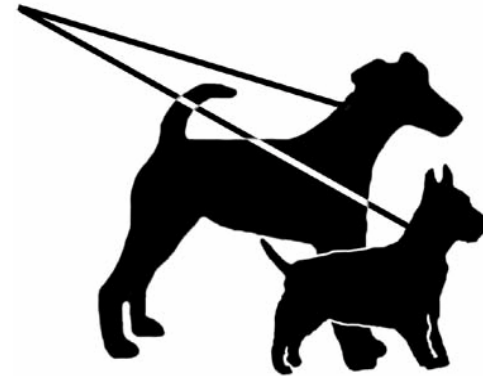

Micro-chipping is a national registry for your pet. The chip is the size of a grain of rice and is placed between your pet's shoulder blades. The shot is not painful and is similar to the animal receiving a booster shot.

Dr. Meade of the Burlington Veterinary Hospital will be administering the AVID® micro-chips at Booth #7.

Micro-chips are \$25 and the proceeds go to Save A Dog.

SILENT AUCTION

How does the silent auction work? Each silent auction item will have a bid sheet with it on the **Silent Auction Table**. To bid, simply write your bid on the item's corresponding sheet with your name and home phone. To keep a tally on how high the bids go, to increase your bid in order to win, and/or if you are the winner, you have to revisit the Silent Auction and bid again or review the bid pages. If you bid, please plan to follow through with your payment and pickup of your item.

Lot 1 closes at 1:45, Lot 2 closes at 2:00pm

Before the close of each lot, an announcement will be made as a reminder to get back to the silent auction table to make a last bid and check items you're interested in. After the lots close, check with the silent auction staff to find out if you've won, gather your item and pay for your purchase(s).

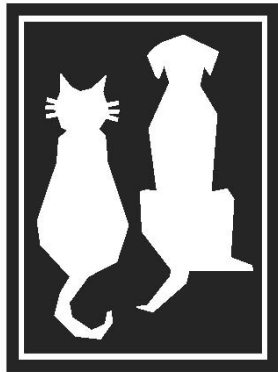

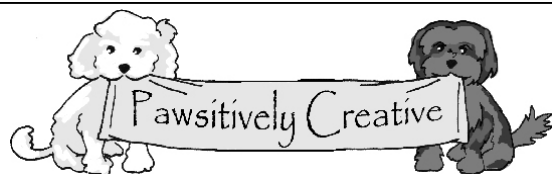
